Cost is \$25. If this date does not work for you, email her and you will be notified the next time she teaches it.

She will be demonstrating using Paper Corners with Tape, T Hinges, Float Mount Hinges, for Original Artwork and Positionable Mounting Adhesive, Perfect Mount and Paper Corners with tape for Photos and inexpensive pieces. You can try any you want, for your piece. I will bring the mounting tapes, glues, etc. you bring your artwork with mat beveled and mounting board.
