Exciting Cutting Edge Digital Drawing Techniques on View at March 4, 2021 ESAL Meeting

We are in for an informational treat this month as our own tech guru, Tom Gallovich, expands our knowledge with a fascinating demonstration of **Digital Drawing techniques**. As he will point out, these programs, including the digital watercolor programs, amazingly mimic the actual watercolor and art experiences.

He will enlighten us with a discussion of some of the cutting edge programs available on the market and demonstrate their amazing capabilities. Tom is eager to demonstrate the possibilities of the newly released program, *Rebelle 4*, that is easier to use than *Photoshop* and that can produce a wide variety of finished art works.

Viewers of this Zoom meeting will be able to observe how the program allows layering of digital paints, enables a virtual choice of papers and palettes, and allows a variety of mediums! Programs such as these can be digitally downloaded on individuals' computers, as Tom will explain.

Tom is working hard to create a "movie" of filmclips to depict the wide variety of possibilities with this innovative medium. The *Rebelle* program is by Escape Emotions and currently excels in the market of digital art. To pique members' interest, those curious may choose to view a slightly earlier version of it on YouTube by Googling *Rebelle 3*.

If time allows, Tom will allow some time for a Q and A period so be sure you do not miss this great opportunity for mind expanding capabilities and enlightenment!

Director, Elaine Biondi Gallery Space Monroeville Public Library

PROFILE

The Director coordinates the artistic exhibits in partnership with the Library and the Friends of the Library. This is a volunteer position facilitating the exhibits with the artist, within the rules of the Library, for the benefit of the Friends of the Monroeville Public Library. The Gallery Space is a section of the Library that is often used for talks, presentations, and special events.

EXHIBITS

Once every 18 months, the Director holds the artists' screening to select artists for the upcoming year. After an agreement is signed, the Director sets up the exhibits with the help of the artist and the Friends volunteers. As items are sold and recorded by the Library staff. At the end of the show, the Director calculates the amounts for the Treasurer to send to the artist, the state sales tax, and the Friends of the Library.

PUBLICITY

For each exhibit, the Director works with the artist to send out news releases to the local media.

SCHEDULING

The Director works with the Library staff reserving the room for the exhibit setup, take-down, and if desired, a reception. This is a wonderful volunteer opportunity to manage an art gallery and network with area artists! Expected reopening is late summer.
