ANNUAL ESAL SHOWS 2022

Show at **Brushes and Beans** scheduled for November/December. See attached registration sheet. Description follows:

Our First Post-pandemic Group Show

As discussed at an earlier meeting, the owners of Brushes and

Beans Café in Murrysville, (Mark and Amanda Clemente) have been

approached about the possibility of hosting a group show for ESAL in

the fall. They both greeted the idea enthusiastically, so a two-month

show for November and December, 2022, has been scheduled. This will replace our show and Christmas/holiday party opening that was previously held at Penn State, New Ken., and will follow much the same format. Entries, (one per person) can be the artists' choice, provided they are originals, completed independently of any classwork. The show will not be judged. However, during the month of November, patrons of the café will be encouraged to vote for People's Choice awards. (ESAL members who visit the show during November are also eligible to vote!) The awards will then be presented at the opening party on December 3rd . Entry forms are being prepared and should be available at the Sept. 1 st meeting, and will also be emailed to members. Paid-up dues (\$25 single or \$30 couples) before October 1 st is required for show participation!

A word about Brushes and Beans for those who are not familiar with this business: They are a fairly new business in Murrysville, and provide a combination coffee café and pottery studio. They are located in the same plaza as Shop 'n Save, along Rt. 22, where there is always plentiful parking.

Since opening about a year and a half ago, they have generously offered their walls as display space for local artists who had been having an especially difficult time finding show venues during the pandemic. They strive to be a community resource in this and other ways. There is no charge for shows, and they retain only a 10% commission for any artwork sales. They handle all sales there, giving the buyer the option of taking their purchase immediately or of leaving it (with a "sold" sticker) until the show's end.

We will be hanging our show on the pottery side of the building, while Gabby Nastuck, formerly the Latrobe Art Center director, will be showing her work in the café area. There is a smaller "party room" off of the café where we are invited to bring and set up our usual assortment of appetizers, desserts, and wine for our party, which will also be open to the public. As a courtesy to our hosts, we are strongly suggesting that our members purchase drinks, other than wine, (and including bottled water) from the café menu.

Other details will be provided on the entry form, and additional questions can be answered at the Sept. meeting. We encourage everyone's participation in this show to kick off our new season of inperson activities! Hope to see you all on September 1 st !
